S-STEM Scholarships

Renewable \$10,000 Annually up to 4 years

Participants must pursue a major in Biology, Chemistry, Physical Science, Environmental Physical Science, or Mathematics. Students must also have demonstrated financial need (as indicated on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, or FAFSA) and have a strong academic record. Students selected for the S-STEM Scholars Program may receive up to \$10,000 in annual scholarship, which is renewable for up to four years. These scholarship dollars can be stacked on top of any other financial aid you receive from Black Hills State University. Applicants must be citizens or nationals of the United States.

Applicants who have completed dual-credit undergraduate courses during high school are eligible and encouraged to apply.

All applications received by May 1st will receive full consideration.

TO APPLY

- Apply for admission to Black Hills State University
- Submit the S-STEM Scholarship application, including:
 - Reference Contact Information:
 - *Provide contact information (first and last name, email address) for a science or math teacher who knows you well and is willing to write a letter of recommendation. Ask that teacher to provide their assessment of you at the link below BHSU.edu/S-StemForm*
 - A response of 350 words (maximum) to the following:
 - *What interests you about science and math and how do you think the additional support offered by the S-STEM Scholars Program will help you succeed in your STEM career?*
- Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which you can access on the FAFSA site Studentaid.gov/apply-for-aid/FAFSA
